



## INVITATION TO BID FOR DEVELOPMENT OF 3 iOS APP

1. The Philippine Information Agency (PIA) intends to apply the sum **EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php800,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) as payment under the contract Development of iOS Application with the Department of Energy – Energy Utilization Management Bureau (DOE-EUMB) project. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The PIA now invites bids for the following Terms of Reference (TOR):

The supplier must:

- Develop and maintain three (3) iOS App for 6 months
- Provide one (1) year App Server hosting
- Prepare monthly reports detailing the work ran out and recommendations

Specific responsibilities include:

- a. Design and build applications for the iOS platform across all releases
- b. Collaborate with DOE teams to define, design and ship controls and features
- c. Lead the entire app life cycle right from concept stage to delivery and post launch support
- d. Unit-test code for robustness, usability, and general reliability
- e. Work on bug fixing and improving application performance
- f. Implement new technologies to maximize development efficiency
- g. Turnover of program codes, administrator manuals and other relevant materials to DOE
- h. Assist the DOE team for the hosting of the developed apps in the Apple Store

Delivery of the goods is required within a period of six months and app server hosting for one (1) year upon approval of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed from the date of submission and receipt of bids a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in **Section II. Instructions to Bidders**.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

4. Interested Bidders may obtain a complete set of Bidding Documents starting

- December 19, 2014 to February 02, 2015** upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of **One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00)** from the PIA Cashier Section, 3F PIA Central Office, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City.
5. The PIA will hold a Pre-Bid Conference open to all interested parties on **January 16, 2015, 3:00p.m** at the 3F Conference Room PIA Central Office, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City.
  6. Bids must be delivered to the PIA, BAC Secretariat, 2F Administrative Division, PIA Central Office, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City on or before **February 02, 2015 at 12:00n**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18. Late bids shall not be accepted.  
  
Bid opening shall be **February 02, 2015, 4:00p.m.** at the 3F Conference Room, PIA Central Office, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
  7. The Bids and Awards Committee of the Philippine Information Agency reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract awards, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
